Presenting the startup ecosystem rankings of 100 countries and 1000 cities

Denmark's startup ecosystem has advanced by 4 points in 2022 in the Global Startup Ecosystem Index

StartupBlink has announced at TBBQ the key results of the Global Startup Ecosystem Index 2022, featuring the most comprehensive research of the global startup economy of 1000 cities and 100 countries. The research is based on the cooperation with Global Data Partners including CrunchBase, SEMrush, UNAIDS and Meetup, and the support of more than 100 governments, municipalities, and economic development organizations.

The Index in the pdf format contains detailed information on the startup scene of 100 countries and includes insights on their most innovative cities, best performing startup industries, unicorns, and notable organizations that contributed to local innovation.

The startup scene of Denmark experienced the best momentum in the top 20 countries ranked in the Global Startup Ecosystem Index. The country advanced 4 spots, now ranking 18th in the world, 12th in Europe, 10th in the EU and 3rd in the Nordic region.

Within the country, Copenhagen jumped 8 spots to rank 53rd in the world, making real progress towards the top 50. Good momentum can be seen also in Aarhus, which increased by 15 places to rank 213th.

"It's exciting to see Denmark finally being part of the top 20 after two years of stability. Aside from the country increasing its cities also has great momentum this year with Copenhagen, Aarhus, and Herning all increasing this year. This great momentum slodifies Denmark and its cities as a startup ecosystem hub." says Katrin Calledo, Partnerships Manager at StartupBlink
